

Getting here (by train, by plane, by road, by bicycle, by walk....)

From Paris:

By train (TGV, bullet train in less than 2 hours) from “Gare de L’Est”

By flight/train landing at the Airport Roissy/Charles de Gaulle and taking the train (TGV) directly at the Airport. AirFrance provides combined air/rail correspondence tickets.

Note: there are no flights from Paris to Strasbourg

From Amsterdam:

By flight from Amsterdam landing to Strasbourg Airport (Entzheim)

From Basel:

By flight/train landing at the airport Mulhouse/Basel. The train station of Saint-Louis is 5 min from the airport by bus where you have to take a TER local train (around 1 hour to reach Strasbourg).

From Frankfurt:

By flight/bus landing to Frankfurt Airport. The Lufthansa bus at the Airport of Frankfurt arrives at the Strasbourg Railway station. Lufthansa provides combined air/bus tickets.

If you arrive at the Strasbourg Airport (Entzheim) you can take a train directly to Strasbourg city center (Railway station) in 8 minutes. See the map to reach the train.

Once you pass the security control and recover the luggage, you arrive in the hall of the airport. You go right and take the tunnel indicated in red. Once you arrive on the other side of the street you will see the train track. The train is in the direction of the arrow.

Buy the ticket on the machine on the left side before entering the tunnel. You need to buy a train/tram ticket. It is 4.6 €. The ticket covers the train and the tram once you arrive at the Strasbourg railway station.
